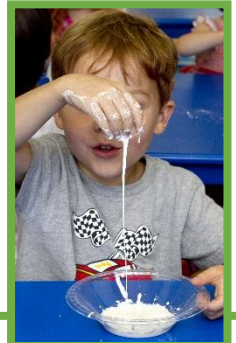
About the Teacher Training
